- Church Cleaning Schedule update from Pastor Carrie The schedule is set through the month of
 May. Before a June, July, August Schedule is set an outside volunteer (LADC contact) may be interested
 in helping out with our church cleaning, but this needs to be confirmed. Pastor Dale will be meeting
 with this person and let us know.

Ministry Team Reports

- Creation Care Team (Kristina) Started using the glass communion cups. After each use they are soaked in a bleach/soap solution and then rinsed and air dried. The cleanup time involved is very minimal. Creation Care Sunday will be on April 28 as way of celebrating Earth Day (4/22) in worship.
- Worship & Music (Pr. Dale/Pr. Carrie) There has been an unusual extra amount of planning given Holy Week, New Member/Baptism, Tanzania Sunday, ENGAGE, and Creation Care Sunday. The Bells, Choir & Band will have a celebratory potluck after Worship May 5. It was suggested that Joanna, Fritz, and Jeanne all are given an appreciation gift. Plans are being made.
- Building & Grounds (Pr. Dale) The main entrance door for the preschool would not open and needed
 maintenance. Dave Haselbauer adjusted it. It works now, but ideally, needs replacing. The dishwasher
 is not dependable and needs replacing. It has needed consistent repairs that Marc M. and Dave H. has
 taken care of. It was suggested to purchase one instead of renting a dishwasher given the relatively
 little amount it is used. LADC (preschool) will pay half of the expense but would like that to go on this
 year's LADC budget ending the first of July, if possible. Further conversation with Dave H. and Marc M.
 is needed and a dishwasher purchase proposal is needed.
- Senior Group (Carole E.) May's activity is a service project helping to serve the community meal at Zion Lutheran Church on May 6, 2024. The monthly activities are planned through December 2024.
- Humble Bees (Karen) Plans for another quilt raffle in the fall. They have been busy making pocket quilts for Tanzania.
- Children, Youth, and Family (Pr. Carrie/Kristina/Christina) Ongoing plans for VBS
- Altar Guild (Kimberly) No report other than the beginning use of glass communion cups. Christina F. brought up a member's concern regarding no bibles in the pews. This was discussed and the Council's decision was made to make NRSV Bibles available on the prayer station table in the back of the Sanctuary for anyone interested. These could be picked up and put back on the way in and out of worship. A note of these available will be included in the bulletin announcements. (The Bibles that were in the pews before the pandemic are the Today's English translation (Good News), which doesn't match the ELCA's recommended NRSV translation for worship.)
- Finance Team(Chris/Andy) On Hold. Chris and Andy are still working together on the treasurer transition completely over to Andy B.
- The Table (Pr. Carrie/Pr. Dale/Deb) there are two more sessions left before summer break. On April 24 there will be a potluck, worship, and then adopt a Highway project.
