Dear Friends,

We are delighted to begin welcoming you back into our sanctuary for worship on Sunday, May 30!

As we do so, your safety, and the safety of others, will continue to be our priority. For this reason, based on the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the counsel of our COVID Response team, we are outlining the following steps and procedures we continue to follow. Please review them with care:

- Worship will continue to begin at 9:00 a.m.
- Doors will be open 30 minutes before worship and the prelude will begin 10 minutes prior to worship.
- All worshipers must sign in for contact tracing and are required to wear a mask (including over the nose).
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the front door and throughout the building.
- To ensure a touch free environment, the order of worship, announcements, and prayer concerns will be projected on the screen; in pew communion with prepackaged communion elements; and an offering plate will be located in the narthex as you enter or exit the sanctuary.
- Please honor social distancing practices and remain six feet apart from other people.
- After worship, the ushers will dismiss the congregation by rows, starting with the back working towards the front of the sanctuary (to maximize social distancing). We request that you please exit the building following worship.

We have worked conscientiously and intentionally to provide a safe worshipping environment as we take this important step at reuniting in-person. Alternating weekly indoor and outdoor services will enable us to gradually, and more safely return indoors.

A reminder that if you are not feeling well, have an underlying health condition or live with someone who does, please stay home and worship with us online. If that is your case, we look forward to seeing you in person when the time is right. And, as we've learned so often over the last year, all of these plans are subject to change depending on the circumstances and in light of what we learn.
